Early Intervention and Help Me Grow Ages Birth To Three

Help Me Grow is a home-based education and service coordination program for children ages 0-3. The Home Visiting program provides first time expectant or new parents with health and child development information. Families receive on-going visits, child assessment, parent education, goal development, and transition to preschool services when the child turns three. Help Me Grow also provides on-going services to ALL children ages 0-3 with developmental delays by providing home visitation, early intervention specialized services, on-going assessment and resource and referral so that the family may work with their child to help achieve desired developmental goals.
