PGC (PerCo Garden Center)



PGC includes traditional greenhouses, the wood product line, candles, stepping stones and the Bio Digester.

The PerCo Bio-Digester is a system for collecting food stock from the local school districts and adding water and heat, with the end product of methane gas to heat the PGC operation. There are different tasks and duties associated with the bio-gas operation.
