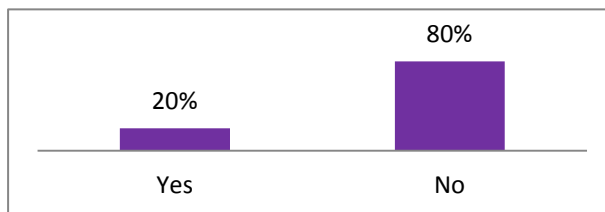

Justice works hard all the time and takes pride in what she does.

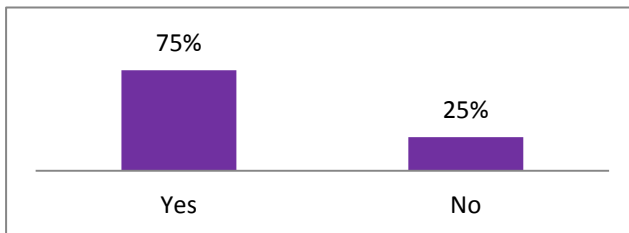
Removed from my class.

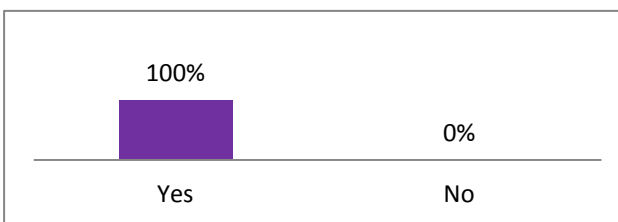
