REFERRAL & ELIGIBILITY is the starting point for services for people with disabilities.

If you wish to receive services you must live in Perry County, have a developmental disability, and meet the eligibility criteria established by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities.

Once determined eligible for services, a Service & Support Administrator (SSA) will be assigned.

SERVICE & SUPPORT ADMINISTRATION formally known as "Service Coordination" is the primary point of coordination. Service & Support Administrators (SSA's) work with people and their teams using person centered planning that focuses on the results the person wants and needs in their life.

SSA's connect with community resources to provide effective development, implementation and coordination of the Individual Service Plan (ISP).

HELP ME GROW (HMG) HOME VISITING is an evidence-based program that promotes healthy growth and development for babies and young children. Home Visiting provides first time expectant or new parents information and supports needed to be prepared for the birth of their child, and provides on-going education and support for families to maximize their child's health and development up to age 3.



PERRY COUNTY EARLY INTERVENTION (EI) provides family-centered services for infants and toddlers up to age 3 with developmental disabilities. EI is grounded in the philosophy that young children learn best from familiar people in familiar settings. The EI team, which includes a Service Coordinator and service providers, works with families in their home or other places families spend time to develop a coordinated plan.

SCHOOL AGE SUPPORTS are available to people ages 6 to 15 who are determined eligible. The School Age Service Coordinator (SSA) supports children and their families to access needed services and supports, and assists with supports for summer camp.

EMPLOYMENT NAVIGATION SUPPORTS are available for children beginning at age 14 who are transitioning into adulthood. The EN works with local school districts, providers, agencies and employers, to help people discover their areas of interest and ability to ultimately gain meaningful community employment.
