➤ WHERE DOES THE MONEY COME FROM TO OPERATE THE PERRY COUNTY DD (PCBDD) PROGRAMS (INCLUDING PERCO AND HELP ME GROW)?

2017 REVENUE SOURCES	% OF TOTAL REVENUE
Local Tax Levy Funds	51%
Federal Funds	24%
Other Sources	15%
State Funds	10%
Total	100%

- In 2005 Perry County DD served 307 people
- In 2018 Perry County DD is serving 411 people, **an increase of 33%**
- The Perry County Board of DD Programs (PCBDD) bring in about \$2.5 million federal funds to our county.

➤ WHAT DO THE PERRY COUNTY DD PROGRAMS PROVIDE?

- Support day services for adults at a variety of locations; including PerCo, Creative Opportunities, Rendville Art Works, New Day Activities, LETS, On the Farm, Gatherings @ Asbury and REA Enterprises, as well as transportation.
- Support for families with children through Early Intervention (EI), Help Me Grow (HMG) and other early childhood and school-age programs.
- Support people with disabilities to live in their communities in a variety of settings.
- Support families with special costs by providing Family Support Services (FSS).
- Provide Service and Support Administration services to develop Individual Service Plans (ISP), Level of Care, and Person Centered Planning, which focuses on the Health and Welfare, Behavior Support Coordination, Money Management, Major Unusual Incidents (MUI's), Employment Navigation and the Academy for Leadership Abilities®.
