Since March 16th, the staff at the Perry County Board of Developmental Disabilities have been working remotely while continuing to provide quality services and supports virtually. Each week, the Senior Leadership Team assesses and evaluates the plans and protocols that would allow us to return to our traditional workspace. At this time, we feel it is best to continue working remotely.

You may see staff intermittently going in and out of our buildings to replenish supplies, process paperwork, or attend a meeting. You may see summer camp operating on a much smaller scale with less than 10 staff and campers attending on a given day. You may see our respite staff and home visitors connecting with children and families outside in their back yard. We are making some adjustments while following our safety plans and protocols, but overall, we continue to limit in-person connections. While things remain uncertain, we assure you our staff continue to do a great job and are adjusting in extraordinary ways so they can to stay connected with you!
