If you wish to receive services and supports you must live in Perry County, have a developmental disability, and meet the eligibility criteria established by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities.

SERVICE & SUPPORT ADMINISTRATION (SSA)

Formally known as "Service Coordination" is the primary point of coordination. Service & Support Administrators (SSAs) work with eligible people and their teams to connect with community resources provide effective development, implementation and coordination of the Individual Service Plan (ISP).

HELP ME GROW (HMG) HOME VISITING

Supports pregnant women or new parents by promoting healthy growth and development for babies and toddlers up to age 3.

EARLY INTERVENTION (EI)

Provides family-centered services for infants and toddlers birth up to age 3 with developmental disabilities. The EI team, works with families to develop a coordinated plan.



PRESCHOOL/EARLY CHILDHOOD SUPPORTS

Supports children ages 3 - 5 who have a diagnoses likely to result in a delay, Part B eligible, IEP through their school district, or determined to be at risk by the developmental team.

SCHOOL-AGE SUPPORTS

Supports eligible youth and their families to access needed services for ages 6 - 15.

EMPLOYMENT NAVIGATION (EN) SUPPORTS

Supports for youth beginning at age 14 to help people discover their areas of interest and ability to ultimately gain meaningful community employment.

COMMUNITY SUPPORTS

ACADEMY FOR LEADERSHIP ABILITIES® (ALA)

Focusing on leadership skills and personal growth strategies. ALA facilitates several leadership sessions in Perry County, working to make the lives of youth, adults and the communities in which they live in better. Through this programming, a leadership seed is being planted to promote integration of ALL people, including those with developmental disabilities into their community.

BEHAVIORAL SUPPORTS

Collaborates with people, families, providers, agencies and schools to assist with development of strategies, trainings and assessments, for eligible children and adults.



PIONEERING POSSIBILITIES® (PP)

A community leadership opportunity offered to ALL people who live or work in Perry County age 18 and older. The group focuses on integrity, doing the right things, setting goals, teamwork, positive mental attitude and accomplishing outcomes to enhance the culture and enrich lives in the community through group sessions and service projects.
